What Is the FEMA Nonprofit Security Grant Program?

The NSGP helps at-risk nonprofits bolster physical security by funding critical upgrades like surveillance, access control, and protective window film systems.

- Who Qualifies: 501(c)(3) nonprofits facing credible threats
- Maximum Award: Up to \$150,000 per facility

What Can the NSGP Fund?

Eligible improvements include:

How to Apply for NSGP Funding

- 1. Confirm 501(c)(3) status
- 2. Contact your State Administrative Agency (SAA)
- 3. Review FEMA's NOFO at Grants.gov
- 4. Conduct a Vulnerability Assessment
- 5. Develop a detailed Investment Justification (IJ)
- 6. Gather cost estimates from qualified vendors like CoolVu
- 7. Submit your application through your SAA

Best Practices for a Strong Application

- Be specific about threats and risks
- Include technical documentation, timelines, and cost quotes
- Collaborate with law enforcement and security consultants
- Tell your story—why your mission or community needs protection
